Guided Farm Tour	60 mins	Showing the children around the farm, introducing them to the different animals and exploring the different food growing on site. There will be opportunities for the children to handle some of our small animals.	£40 (However no school turned away for lack of funds) 15 children max.
Animal workshops	60 mins	<p>Introduction to farm animals: A general introduction to farm animals, baby animals, animal sounds and animal feed. Baby Animals: Focus on meeting and naming animal babies.</p> <p>Life cycle of a chicken: Focus on eggs and chickens, naming hens, cockerels and chicks. Includes a chance to meet our chicks or chickens, depending on the season.</p> <p>Three Little Pigs: Encountering and naming different building materials on the farm and meeting & feeding our pigs or piglets, depending on the season.</p> <p>Three Billy Goats Gruff: Meeting and feeding the goats and goat kids on the farm and making links to the traditional story.</p>	£40 (However no school turned away for lack of funds) 15 children max.
Gardening workshops	60 mins	<p>Plants & food growing: A more indepth look at the plants growing on the farm, what they need in order to grow and what they provide us with.</p> <p>Seasonal change: observing and interacting with the indicators of seasonal change. Includes a practical gardening activity such as planting bulbs, raking leaves, sowing seeds or harvesting produce.</p> <p>Sensory tour: finding, smelling,</p>	£40 (However no school turned away for lack of funds) 15 children max.
