ACTIVITY	TIME	LEARNING OBJECTIVES
Guided Farm Tour	60-90 mins depending on group	Understanding of what is produced on a farm and how; how farm animals and plants provide for people's needs, and what the different parts of the farm are used for.
Farm to Fork: Food Systems	90 mins	Understanding that all food comes from a plant or an animal, and that fruit and vegetables grow in the ground. Understanding that food is imported from all around the world as well as growing here.
Plants, food growing & gardening	90 mins	Understanding what plants need to grow, and that we eat different parts of the plant. Practical experience of a seasonal gardening activity
Use it Again! Waste & Cycles	90 mins	Understanding that most rubbish goes to Landfill & how recycling & reusing can help the environment. Understanding that food waste can be composted, & that worms help to break it down.
Introduction to Farm Animals	90 mins	Understanding which animals live on the Farm and what they need to stay healthy.
Lifecycle of a Chicken	90 mins	Recognise a chicken and the difference between a hen, cockerel and chick, understand that chickens have needs, some of which are similar to humans and realise that chickens lay eggs, that eggs hatch into a chick which turns in to a chicken and that this process is called a life cycle.
